## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course offers a review of important and timely topics in the field of perinatal medicine. Based on a review of the literature, input from our own expert faculty, and analyses from past conferences, we are proud to offer a comprehensive program with topics that include: Vaginal birth after cesarean section; shoulder dystocia and brachia plexus palsy; noninvasive prenatal testing; evidence-based oxytocin and labor management; fetal growth disorders; pre-term labor; intrapartum fetal hear rate monitoring; nausea and vomiting in pregnancy; progesterone use in pregnancy; management of stillbirth; and amniotic fluid embolism. Lectures by USC faculty from the Keck School of Medicine and distinguished guest faculty from the University of California, Irvine and Baylor College of Medicine will outline controversies, discuss recent developments, and suggest recommendations. Participants have direct access to the speakers and ample opportunity for intensive question and answer post-lecture discussions.

## TARGET AUDIENCE

The program was developed for gynecologists, obstetricians, perinatolgists, neonatolgists, nurses, nurse midwives and other allied health professionals. It is USC's mission that this educational opportunity provide participants with objective, evidence-based clinical content, to incorporate into their practices and improve the clinical care and further the well-being of their patients.

## COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- Assess current literature regarding the risks and management of preterm labor.
- Formulate a practical plan to manage the potential complications of vaginal birth after cesarean section.
- Describe and incorporate a plan for the safe use of oxytocin in pregnancy.
- Apply practical tips to thoroughly assess and manage nausea and vomiting in pregnancy.
- Describe a practical approach to diagnosis and management of noninvasive prenatal testing.
- Assess the controversies surrounding progesterone prophylaxis and preterm birth.
- Implement a plan to manage placenta previa.
- Construct a practical algorithm for the management of hypertensive disorders in pregnancy.
- Apply a standardized approach to fetal heart rate monitoring terminology, interpretation and management.
- Describe the risk and treatment strategies for second stage labor management.
- Implement current recommendations regarding the management of stillbirth.
- Manage the risks associated with shoulder dystocia.
- Understand the risks and treatment options for amniotic fluid embolism.
